Key Features of Enterprise Recon 2.10

The key features and benefits introduced in Enterprise Recon 2.10 include:

- **Discovery scanning for Confluence**: Scanning is now available for Confluence on-premises deployments, enabling businesses to scan all or specific spaces, blog posts and pages, including comments and attachments.
- Remediation support for OneDrive Business and SharePoint Online: The
 ability to mask, delete or quarantine sensitive data is now available for OneDrive
 Business and SharePoint Online, further enhancing data management
 capabilities for these environments.
- Scanning and remediation for the latest macOS versions: Enterprise Recon 2.10 now supports data discovery and remediation of macOS Ventura 13.0 and macOS Sonoma 14.0 workstations and servers.
- New and improved data types: Two new data types are included in this release
 for Singaporean bank account numbers and driver's license numbers. Further
 updates include the addition of Australia R Series passport numbers, and support
 for common formats of Minnesota driver's license numbers.
- New and improved user interface for Investigate and Match Inspector.
